Permit is good from date issued to December 31 of the current year. After that date, the cache must be moved or removed and the new location re-permitted.

Caches are to be monitored monthly and maintained as a family friendly cache. Caches should contain no food, alcohol, firearms, drugs, dangerous items or adult items.

All caches need to be within 20' of an already established park trail. We discourage off trail hiking as it negatively impacts the environment.
